The fund is named in honor of our rescued cat, Phoenix. She was a brave little warrior who was burned alive but through sheer determination and the will to live, Phoenix managed to survive for a week on her own until she was finally found in a garbage pile and rescued. Phoenix fought to live for almost another week until she couldn't fight anymore. Phoenix's remains were cremated and her ashes are now in her forever home at PART's Paws and Claws Animal Sanctuary (PCAS) in San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan.

Phoenix's story captured many hearts across the world. She opened the eyes of many to the suffering of stray animals. She was the face that showed us that people will stop at nothing to hurt, maim, and kill innocent animals. But she also reminded us that while there are animal abusers everywhere, there are good people everywhere, too. From the person who found and helped her, to the people that sent prayers and well wishes, and especially the many people that donated for her care and treatment.

The Phoenix Fund honors her memory and legacy by providing homeless, neglected, and abused animals a chance to be reborn. The Phoenix symbolizes renewal. Every animal rescued by PART is given the chance to rise through the ashes and obtain a new life through Phoenix and the Phoenix Fund.

Funds raised through our Phoenix Fund will be used to pay for the care and treatment of our rescues so that we can continue our lifesaving work of rescuing homeless, abandoned, neglected, and abused animals.
