

THESIS REQUIREMENTS

As a nonprofit, non-government animal welfare group we have very limited manpower resources to respond to emails and/or inquiries about the sanctuary.

In order to make the process easier please provide the following:

1. Written commitment letter that information you receive from PART will be used only for the purposes of YOUR studies. This letter should include the school's name and contact number, your name, and your professor's name. Once received, please email a copy to us at: mail@philanimalrescue.org and at this point, attach a list of your questions. PART will respond within 5 business days.
2. We also require students to make at least one 8-hour visit to the sanctuary to gain a full understanding of the welfare of animals in shelters, pounds, and, in our case, the sanctuary. You can schedule your visit at www.pcas.setmore.com and note that your visit is for your thesis.
3. Before you submit your thesis paper, provide PART a copy of your thesis, research paper, reaction paper, any videos, photos and other materials used by emailing it to mail@philanimalrescue.org.

IMPORTANT: If you do not submit the above for PART's approval we will contact your professor to let them know that your thesis wasn't approved by PART.

4. We also require that students bring in at least a bag of dog food, cat food, turtle food or chicken food or turkey food. Please understand that we are a non-profit group with very limited resources and manpower. When we spend time with you to complete your thesis we are taken from other task that would have benefitted the PART fur kids.
